During the course of Project Web, we will discuss how the Web and new Media technologies shape and change the way we interact as a society. As a class, we will consider the different positive and negative effects of new technologies, exploring their larger implications on society as a whole. We will further explore the effectiveness of multi-media composition, further understanding the usefulness of including images, video and animation to web posts

Project Web is your chance to explore a topic of your choice. You may write a personal narrative exploring your own history with technology. How did you learn to navigate in Cyber Space? How many ways can the Web be used? Have all your experiences been positive?

In preparing to write your narrative, you may find it helpful to ask such questions as: Why is this experience important to me? What details are necessary in order for me to recreate the experience in an interesting and engaging way? How can my narrative of the experience be most effectively organized? Over what period of time did the experience occur?

Whatever you decide to write about, be sure to tell the story of what happened and let us know what effect the experience had on you.

Concentrate on narrating the story in your own voice, but keep in mind that your audience is university-level readers.

Final drafts must typed, double-spaced, in Times New Roman .12 point font, and with one inch margins. There should be three sources cited and a list of works cited. A rough draft of this paper will be due in class on Monday, Apr. 14th. The second draft will be due on Wednesday, Apr. 16th, and the final draft will be due on Monday, Apr. 21st.
