1. The Purpose of This Course Assignment

On successful completion of this course assignment, students will be able to:

- a) Understand the current construction issues and practices.
- b) Understand the modern methods of construction.

2. Scenario Outline

Four Dragons Hotel Services Company Limited ("Four Dragons") is a large hotel chain in the U.S.A. Four Dragons have a strategy of developing a hotel line in Hong Kong but their senior personnel have no experience in Hong Kong hotel design & construction.

The Board of Four Dragons ("the Client") intends to open two hotels located in Kowloon District and New Territories District respectively. These hotels consist of:

- 27-storey of hotel rooms.
- 1 level of 3.5m high basement.
- Save energy building services installation.
- Good appearance facades.

3. Tasks

Assume that you have been appointed as the design and construction consultant to the Client. Your role is to produce a comprehensive and exhaustive development proposal to the Client describing the current construction methods & design and advising on the most appropriate construction method for the above development project.

The development proposal should include:

1. Analyse the key construction issues that Client has to consider in selecting an appropriate foundation system for the hotel construction .(P 1.1)

- 2. Explain how will these construction issues affect your selection of an appropriate foundation system and draw an A-3 size drawing showing details of piled foundation system including the lowest slab of the hotel. (P1.2)
- 3. As one of the hotel projects will be located in the New Territories where greenfield and brownfield developments are both available for the client's consideration. Describe the nature, advantage and disadvantage of both development types. (P1.3)
- 4. The other hotel project will be located in the commercial centre of Kowloon District where an existing vacant three star ranking hotel and a cleared site will be available for both development and redevelopment. Compare the new development and redevelopment project types. List out the advantages and disadvantages of each type. (P1.4)
- 5. The Client heard that modern methods of construction is widely used in Hong Kong and would like to know more if this can be used in the hotel development projects.
 - (a) Discuss <u>four</u> types of modern methods of construction for the Client's consideration. (P2.1)
 - (b) Other than discussing modern methods of construction, the Client would like to know how modern methods of construction affect the traditional design process. (P2.2)
