

My good people: the main purpose/ goals of the "integrative paper" are to prepare you for a potential employer interview where you are likely to be asked: what is your definition of leadership? How would you describe your leadership potential and areas of growth? What area of leadership research or concept interests you the most (area of interest)? And, what are the threads that connect these concepts together that make you a well rounded leader?  
(conclusion/integration)

Lastly, most of you will ponder graduate school, sooner or later, and most graduate writing uses APA style. Therefore, I've attached the following little overview of APA guidelines to focus on.

If you'd like me to preview your paper, before submission, that would be fine.

APA Style: an overview of a few guidelines

**Integrative Paper guidelines and grading rubric: 45 pts. (I may use "Safe Assign" via Bb)**

Minimum of 7 pages of narrative, APA, with a running header and p. #s

Use a title/cover page (name, class, CWU, Title, date), References on separate page

- Introduction/purpose (.5 pg.: 5 pts.)
- Personal definition of leadership (.5 pg.: 5 pts.)
- Self-evaluation/self-assessment summary using MBTI, Big 5, Emotional Intelligence, etc. (2 pgs. +or-: 10 pts.)
- Delve into one area of interest (e.g. Maslow's Hierarchy, Self-efficacy/Bandura, learning styles, morale, The Ken Blanchard Companies, contingency theory, situational leadership, rewards, Servant Leadership, team development, emotional intelligence, etc., with at least one scholarly reference (separate from/in addition to our texts), appropriately cited in the narrative (3 pgs. +or-: 10 pts.)
- Integration and conclusion/summary (.5 pg. +or-: 5 pts.)
- Have a separate reference page with at least one scholarly reference (neither the texts, nor web-sourced will be considered as the one minimum scholarly reference)
- Overall writing, grammar, APA Style, reference page, coherence, Apple person (10 pts.)

Cover page:

Top left- "RUNNING HEADER: last name: one or two-word title"

- Title of paper in caps and centered
- Do not use bold or underlining for anything
- Use section headings



- Sections are centered with caps for only first letters (except of, with, for)
- Number each page (except title page) on top right
- Punctuation goes "inside the quotes."
- All quotes need author, year and page number (Trumpy, 2007, p. 34)
- Book titles are italicized
- Running header is top left (e.g. your last name and a one/two word title)
- Do not use contractions (vs. don't)
- Document is completely double-spaced (even between paragraphs and sections)
- Size 12 font
- One-inch margins
- Minimum two sentences per paragraph
- Separate reference page, entitled References

Therefore, you'll submit a minimum of 9 pieces of paper- a cover page, 7 full pages of writing, and a reference page.
