



■ **Mandatory Graded Assignment**



Directions: Be sure to make a copy of your answer before submitting it to Ashworth College for grading. Unless otherwise stated, answer in complete sentences, and be sure to use correct English spelling and grammar. Sources must be cited in APA format. Your response should be a minimum of one (1) single-spaced page to a maximum of two (2) pages in length.

For this lesson, you will be required to write three (3) narrative reports about the following bank robbery investigation. You are to assume the role of the lead investigator assigned to the crime. First, write an **evidence narrative**, describing the investigation that located the evidence listed below. Second, write a **crime investigation narrative** based on the witness information. Third, write a **suspect investigation narrative** based on an interview of Officer Jackson.

Your report must be neatly typewritten using 12-point font, double-spaced. Include your name and student number on every page. Your report will be graded on how well it conveys the required information and how well it adheres to the five rules of narrative writing. Spelling, punctuation, and grammar *do* count, so proofread your work *carefully* before submitting it. When referring to a handgun, the correct way to note a gun is ".38 caliber" (with a decimal point). Omit irrelevant details that add nothing to the report and are irrelevant to the investigation. **Reports that do not meet minimum requirements will be returned for revision.**
