

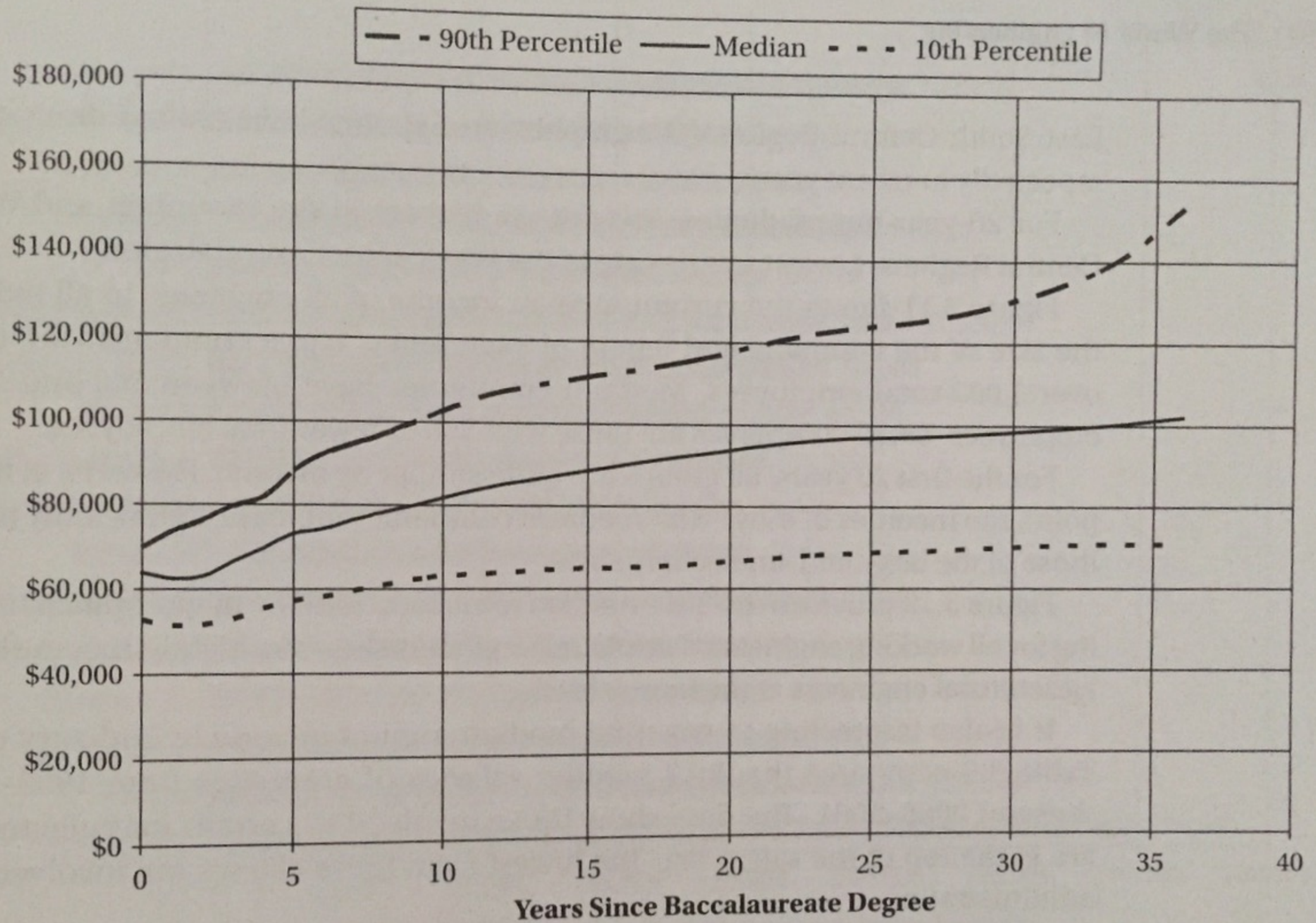


Figure 3.9 Salary curves for engineering non-supervisors, all degree levels

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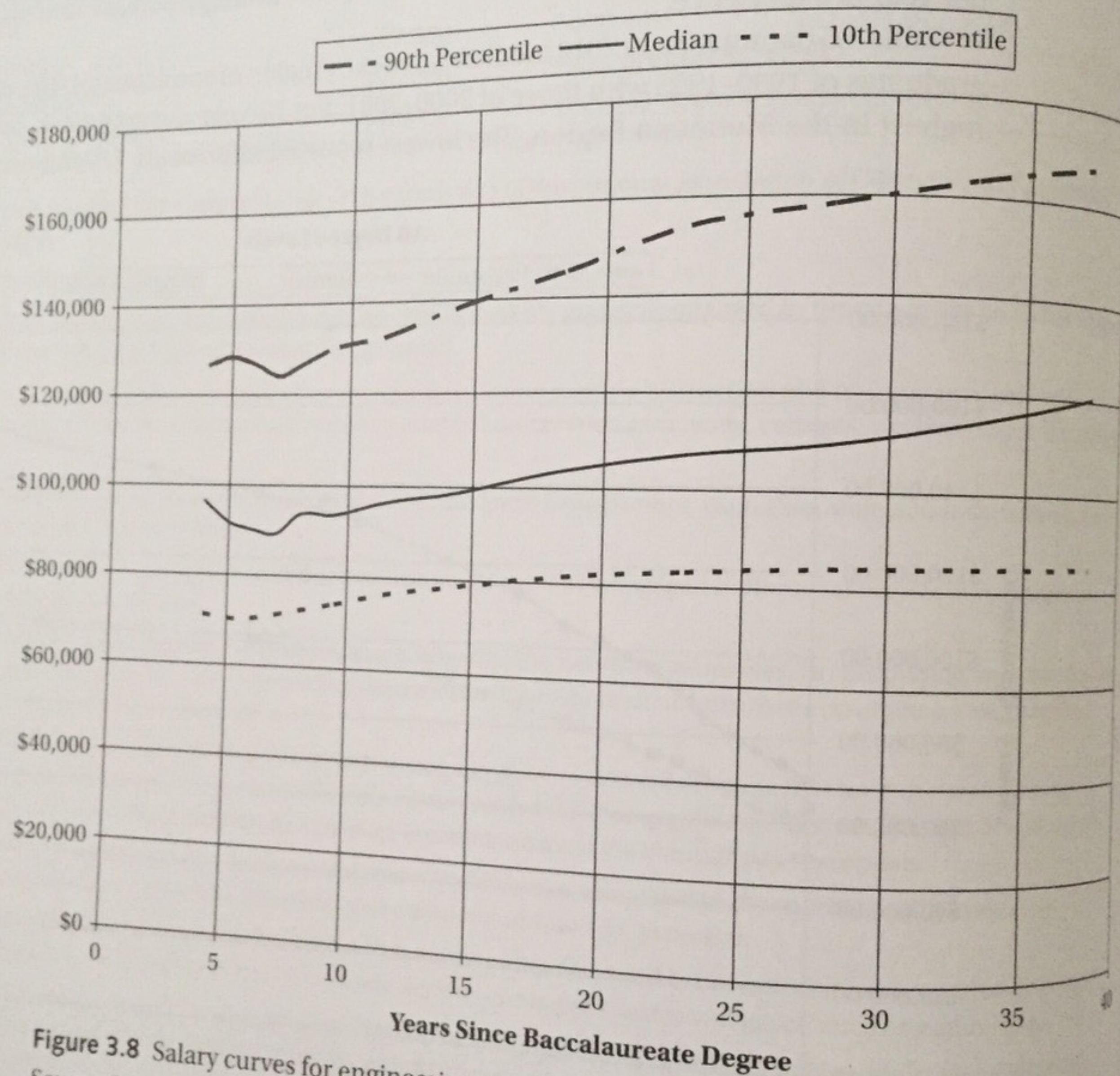


Figure 3.8 Salary curves for engineering supervisors, all degree levels
