

Worth ten points each:

Paraphrase each of the following quotes from *Othello*.

Paraphrase means to put it in your own words- in other words, tell me what the quote means but do so line by line, not by simply summarizing the quote. Here is an example:

Original:

Gentlemen all, I do suspect this trash
To be a party in this injury.—
Patience awhile, good Cassio.—Come, come,
Lend me a light. Know we this face or no?
Alas, my friend and my dear countryman
Roderigo! No—yes, sure! Yes, 'tis Roderigo.

Paraphrase:

Sir, I believe this piece of trash, Bianca, has something to do with all this trouble.—Hang in there, Cassio.—Come here, bring the light. Do you recognize this face? Oh, no, it's my friend and countryman, Roderigo.—Yes, it's Roderigo!

You MAY use a dictionary to help you understand unfamiliar terms or vocabulary, but once again, I want you to put these excerpts into your own words, so please, DO NOT PLAGIARIZE.

1: (Desdemona, I.iii.182)

My noble father,
I do perceive here a divided duty.
To you I am bound for life and education.
My life and education both do learn me
How to respect you. You are the lord of duty.
I am hitherto your daughter. But here's my husband.
And so much duty as my mother showed
To you, preferring you before her father,
So much I challenge that I may profess
Due to the Moor my lord.

2: (Iago, IV.i.35)

Work on, My medicine, work! Thus credulous fools are caught,
And many worthy and chaste dames even thus,
All guiltless, meet reproach.
