

**ENTC Campus Event or Club Meeting  
Reflection Paper  
(100 points)**

**Campus Activity Option:** Attend one activity or special event on the ETSU campus that is designed for students and answer the following questions:

- a. When and where was the activity/event held? How did the scheduling impact (day, date, time, location) impact program on campus? (25 points)
- b. Describe the purpose of the event and the program; educational, fun, sports, etc. Was it a one time event/activity or an ongoing one? What were the positives and negatives of the activity/event? (25 points)
- c. Who sponsored the event/activity? Was it an ETSU department or student volunteers? (You may need to ask questions of the leaders or presenters to answer these questions.) (25 points)
- d. Describe your experience at the activity, did you learn anything or did you enjoy yourself? Do you plan on attending similar program on campus in the future? Why or why not. (25 points)

**Student Organization meeting option:** Attend a meeting of an ETSU student organization. Examples would be faith based programs, Greek Letter Societies, major's associations, political/social action interest groups, sports clubs, etc and answer the following questions:

- a. What is the mission and purpose of the club or organization?
- b. Describe both the people leading the meeting and the people who attended it.
- c. What types of activities does the club/organization participate in? What is the time commitment required of a typical member? Are there any extra costs, membership dues, etc.?
- d. Do you plan on becoming an active member? Why or why not? (25 points)
