

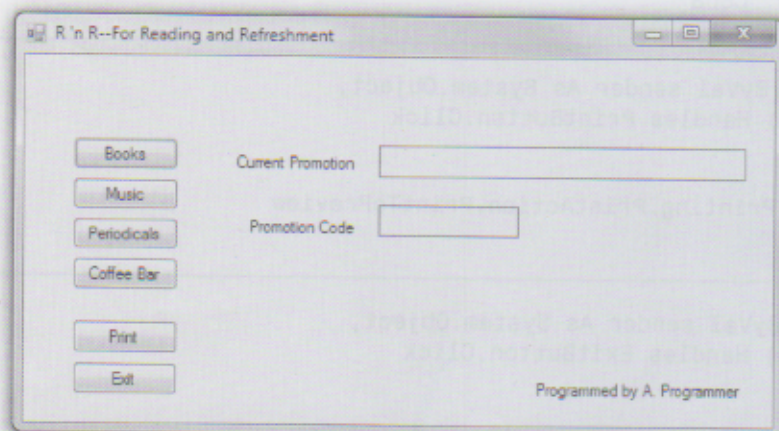
CoffeeBarButton_Click	Display "Celebrate the season with 20% off specialty drinks" and code C608.
